
# MAPPING THE PSALMS


Lesson One

#### Look for the answers to these questions:


- 1. What biblical category does the Book of Psalms fit into?

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The Bible story is interesting and dramatic, but most important, it is the Word of God given to transform our lives.




As we meditate upon of the Word of God, his light floods our soul and changes us into his image.




#### 2 Corinthians 3:18


But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, *even* as by the Spirit of the Lord.



This transformation does not happen overnight. A consistent diet of the Word of God is required.




#### Luke 4:4 And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.




Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts.



### In our pursuit of holy living, we are specifically directed to the Psalms:




Ephesians 5:18-19

<sup>19</sup> Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;




#### Colossians 3:16




James 5:13 Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms.




By definition, "psalms" are lyrical poems sung to the accompaniment of musical instruments. THE Psalms are the 150 chapters


conveniently located in the middle of the Bible.




Inspired people can write inspirational songs, but only God can give us his living Word. Biblical psalms have the distinction of being birthed by God, and this puts them in their own unique category.




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
The book of Psalms is classified as one of the five biblical books of Poetry, along with Job, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, and the Song of Solomon.



### Psalms is the largest and probably most widely read book in the Bible.



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The man 2 Samuel 23:1 calls "the sweet psalmist of Israel" wrote 75.

73 by name, 2 more are attributed to him by New Testament writers (Ps 2 in Acts 2:25; Ps 95 in Hebrews 4:7).

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
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








We also get a look into the minds of those who are wicked and evil.
