





The Jews wanted to move things along.

John 19:31

The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, (for that sabbath day was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away.



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Breaking the legs caused the men to suffocate so they died faster.



The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, (for that sabbath day was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away.

The preparation began the afternoon of Nisan 14, preparing for the Passover meal that would be eaten later that day.








John 19:31

The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, (for that sabbath day was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away.

This sabbath was not the seventh day of the week, but a holy day that marked the start of the Feast of Unleavened Bread on the evening of Nisan 15.



When the soldiers came to Jesus, he was already dead.


John 19:32-35

- Then came the soldiers, and brake the legs of the first, and of the other which was crucified with him.
- ³³ But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs:
- 34 But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water.
- 35 And he that saw it bare record, and his record is true: and he knoweth that he saith true, that ye might believe.

This, too, was in fulfillment of prophecy.



Luke 23:47-49

- 47 Now when the centurion saw what was done,he glorified God, saying,Certainly this was a righteous man.
- ⁴⁸ And all the people that came together to that sight, beholding the things which were done, smote their breasts, and returned.
- ⁴⁹ And all his acquaintance, and the women that followed him from Galilee, stood afar off, beholding these things.

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

Luke 23:50-52

- 50 And, behold, there was a man named Joseph, a counsellor; and he was a good man, and a just:
- ⁵¹ (The same had not consented to the counsel and deed of them;) he was of Arimathaea, a city of the Jews: who also himself waited for the kingdom of God.
- ⁵² This man went unto Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus.




John tells us more about Joseph:

John 19:38

38 And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave him leave.

He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.



Joseph was not alone in this work:


John 19:39-40

- 39 And there came also Nicodemus, which at the first came to Jesus by night, and brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about an hundred pound weight.
- ⁴⁰ Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury.




John 19:41-42

- Now in the place where he was crucified there was a garden; and in the garden a new sepulchre, wherein was never man yet laid.
- ⁴² There laid they Jesus therefore because of the Jews' preparation *day*; for the sepulchre was nigh at hand.






It took time for Joseph to get permission from Pilate, and then take Jesus down from the cross.



Luke 23:54-56


- ⁵⁴ And that day was the preparation, and the sabbath drew on.

- ⁵⁶ And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the sabbath day according to the commandment.







The women probably went to Bethany to observe the Feast of Unleavened Bread.





They rested during the Sabbath.





They would return to the tomb early Sunday morning.



Remember the sign of Jonah:



For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.






Jesus died on the afternoon of Passover.





Matthew 27:62-64

- ⁶² Now the next day, that followed the day of the preparation, the chief priests and Pharisees came together unto Pilate,
- 63 Saying,
 Sir, we remember that that deceiver said,
 while he was yet alive,
 After three days I will rise again.
- Command therefore that the sepulchre be made sure until the third day, lest his disciples come by night, and steal him away, and say unto the people, He is risen from the dead:
 so the last error shall be worse than the first.







- 65 Pilate said unto them, Ye have a watch: go your way, make it as sure as ye can.
- So they went, and made the sepulchre sure, sealing the stone, and setting a watch.





