The Events of the Morning of Resurrection Sunday

- 1. Sometime before dawn, the women return to the sepulchre intending to anoint the Lord's body for burial, worried about how they would move the stone.
- 2. They arrive at the tomb and find it open and empty.
- 3. Mary Magdalene runs to tell the men that someone had taken the Lord's body.
- 4. The women who remained at the tomb are greeted by an angel who tells them, "He is not here. He is risen." They are instructed to tell the disciples to go to Galilee where they will see Jesus. The women leave to find the disciples.
- 5. Peter and another disciple, along with Mary, return to the empty tomb.


 After seeing the grave clothes, the men return home, leaving Mary by herself.
- 6. Two angels comfort Mary.
- 7. Jesus appears to Mary.




- 8. Jesus appears to the other women on their way to speak to the disciples, and gives them the same message: Tell the eleven they will see me in Galilee.

- 12. Peter returns to the empty sepulchre, and leaves again.





