

Remember that every message follows this pattern:

- 1) A SALUTATION or greeting
- 2) A COMMENDATION or word of praise\*
- 3) A REBUKE or word of disapproval\*\*
- 4) An ADMONITION or word of counsel
- 5) An EXHORTATION or word of encouragement
  - \* Sardis and Laodicea are not praised.
  - \*\* Smyrna and Philadelphia are not rebuked.



Wickedness was so common in Pergamos that Jesus said Satan's seat [or his throne] was located there.

#### Revelation 2:13



Even in the midst of such evil, this church remained faithful.





According to Christian tradition, Antipas was the bishop of Pergamon during the reign of the Roman emperor Nero (AD 54-68).



Antipas was burned to death inside a bull-shaped altar made of brass, because he taught against the ancestral gods worshiped by the local population.



This church did good works, but there were still some things that needed to change.

#### Rebuke

#### Revelation 2:14-15

- because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.

The idolatrous teachings of Balaam and the Nicolaitans were polluting the church.

#### Rebuke

#### Revelation 2:14-15

- But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.

Balaam knew that no weapon formed against Israel would prosper if they walked with God.

But he knew that if he could lead them into idolatry, they would defeat themselves. And that is what he did!

- But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.

It was the doctrine of Balaam –
a doctrine that encouraged idolatry and
the sexual sins that go with it –
that lead to the death of 23,000 in
"the matter of Peor."



#### Numbers 31:16

Behold, these caused the children of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to commit trespass against the LORD in the matter of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the LORD.

#### Rebuke

#### Revelation 2:14-15

- But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- 15 So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.

In his message to the church of Ephesus, the Lord said he hated "the DEEDS of the Nicolaitans." Now we see that he also hates "the DOCTRINE of the Nicolaitans."



#### Admonition

#### Revelation 2:16

or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

Christ always gives a church the chance to repent before he deals out their punishment.

#### **Matthew Henry Commentary**

"When God comes to punish the corrupt members of a church, he rebukes that church itself for allowing such to continue in its communion, and some drops of the storm fall upon the whole society."

A new name – our new identity in Christ.





#### Revelation 2:20

Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat

things sacrificed unto idols.

But not everything was good. They were being led into idolatry by a false prophetess.

#### Rebuke

#### Revelation 2:20

Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

#### Rebuke

#### Revelation 2:21

<sup>21</sup> And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

The time for repentance is now. Tomorrow may be too late.

#### Rebuke

### Revelation 2:22-23

- <sup>22</sup> Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.
- <sup>23</sup> And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

When Christ begins the Rapture of the Church, the opportunity to repent and avoid the Great Tribulation will be over.

#### Admonition

#### Revelation 2:24-25

- <sup>24</sup> But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.
- <sup>25</sup> But that which ye have *already* hold fast till I come.

Thankfully, this corruption had not spread throughout all the church.

- <sup>28</sup> And I will give him the morning star.


We read about the morning star in **Revelation 22:16**

 and the bright and morning star.


