



At this time, the Bride of Christ has already been carried into heaven.

On Earth, the first 3½ years of the Antichrist's reign (the peaceful years) have ended.

When these seals are broken, the Great Tribulation begins.

Chapter 6: The opening of the first six seals

verses 1-8: The first 4 seals and the 4 men on horses.



¹ And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals,

and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying,

Come and see.



And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.



The first horseman is THE ANTICHRIST, pretending to be the savior on a white horse. But just like the devil who comes only to steal, to kill, and to destroy (John 10:10), the antichrist comes only to conquer.



And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.



And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.



RED is the color of BLOOD, and the sword is a symbol of WAR. "For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape" (1 Thess 5:3).



And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see.



Revelation 6:5b-6

- 5 ... And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances [measuring scales] in his hand.
- ⁶ And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and *see* thou hurt not the oil and the wine.



The Black Horse signifies FAMINE.

Food will be in short supply, and the payment for a full day's work ["a penny"] will not be enough to buy one day of food. The preservation of oil and wine may point to special protection of God's elect during famine times.






And when he had opened the fifth seal,
I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of
God, and for the testimony which they held:





- ¹⁰ And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?
- And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.



- And they cried with a loud voice, saying,
 How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge
 our blood on them that dwell on the earth?
- And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.

In this vision, John sees the Tribulation martyrs waiting to be resurrected.

They are able to speak from the grave only because this is a vision, not an literal truth. "For the living know that they shall die: but the dead know not any thing" (Eccl. 9:5).

The four winds are God's judgment of the earth.

Four angels hold back the judgment until God's servants can be protected.

Revelation 7:2-3

- And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,
- Saying,
 Hurt not the earth,
 neither the sea,
 nor the trees,
 till we have sealed the servants
 of our God in their foreheads.

 of our God in their foreheads.





The 144,000 who are sealed by God will be able to stand in the great day of his wrath.

Revelation 7:4-8

- ⁴ And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.
- Of the tribe of Juda were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Reuben were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Gad were sealed twelve thousand.
- ⁶ Of the tribe of Aser were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Nepthalim were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Manasses were sealed twelve thousand.
- Of the tribe of Simeon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Levi were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Issachar were sealed twelve thousand.
- ⁸ Of the tribe of Zabulon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Joseph were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Benjamin were sealed twelve thousand.

The 144,000 are believers from the 12 tribes of Israel.
