



1-8 The Seven Vial Angels, and the chorus of 144,000



 And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.



Before the horrors of the third "woe" is revealed, John's vision jumps forward to the millennial age when the battle is over, and the war is won.

And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire:
and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, *and* over the number of his name,

stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.

³ And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying,

Great and marvellous *are* thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true *are* thy ways, thou King of saints.

 Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest.

After this word of comfort, the narrative returns to the terror of the seven angels and their vials of wrath.




Revelation 15:5-6




And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels,



and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain,


¹¹ And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores,


