





While the Great Tribulation takes place on earth, the Bride of Christ is wedded to her Bridegroom in heaven. There is the time of the joyous celebration called the Marriage Supper of the Lamb.



- <sup>4</sup> And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia.
- <sup>5</sup> And a voice came out of the throne, saying,

Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great.





- <sup>6</sup> And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters,
  - and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying,
  - Alleluia:
  - for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth.
- <sup>7</sup> Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.




- <sup>8</sup> And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

The angel of God had surprisingly little to tell John about Christ's return to earth. So before we read these seven verses, let us read what was said by the angels on the day of Christ's ascension, by the prophets Zechariah and Joel, and finally, by Jesus himself.

### Spoken by the angels on the day Christ ascended


#### Acts 1:10-12


<sup>10</sup> And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel;

- <sup>11</sup> Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.
- <sup>12</sup> Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a sabbath day's journey.



Zechariah also prophesied that Christ would return to the very same place he departed from – the Mount of Olives.





### Zechariah 14:3-4, 5b

- <sup>3</sup> Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.
- And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.
- ... and the LORD my God shall come, and all the saints with thee.



### Zechariah 14:3-4, 5b

- <sup>3</sup> Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.
- <sup>4</sup> And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof

toward the east and toward the west,

and there shall be a very great valley;

and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north,

This newly-formed valley will be the site of the ultimate war between good and evil.


# This is "the valley of decision" and "the valley of Jehoshaphat" foretold by the prophet Joel.

### Joel 3:12-13

<sup>12</sup> Let the heathen be wakened, and come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat: for there will I sit to judge all the heathen round about.
<sup>13</sup> Put ye in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe: come, get you down; for the press is full, the fats overflow; for their wickedness *is* great.

### Joel 3:14-16

- <sup>14</sup> Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision: for the day of the LORD *is* near in the valley of decision.
- <sup>15</sup> The sun and the moon shall be darkened, and the stars shall withdraw their shining.
- <sup>16</sup> The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD will be the hope of his people, and the strength of the children of Israel.



### This prophesy was spoken by Christ himself:

### Matthew 24:29-30

<sup>29</sup> Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:
<sup>30</sup> And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

We now read the angel's testimony to John:

<sup>11</sup> And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him *was* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

- <sup>12</sup> His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.
- <sup>13</sup> And he *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood:

and his name is called The Word of God.



<sup>14</sup> And the armies *which were* in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

<sup>15</sup> And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations:
 and he shall rule them with a rod of iron:
 and he treadeth the winepress
 of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

After the Marriage Supper of the Lamb, a second, terrible supper is announced.

- <sup>17</sup> And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven,
  - Come and gather yourselves together unto **the supper of the great God;**
- <sup>18</sup> That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all *men*, both free and bond, both small and great.

Revelation 19:19-20 <sup>19</sup> And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army. <sup>20</sup> And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image.



Revelation 19:19-20 <sup>19</sup> And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army. <sup>20</sup> And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image.



### "The beast" can refer to either the antichrist or his kingdom. Here, it refers to the man.



<sup>20</sup> These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.



<sup>21</sup> And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth:

### **Revelation 19:21** <sup>21</sup> ... and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.
