The remainder of Chapter 21 is John's testimony of the things he saw in the Holy Jerusalem.




- And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,
- Having the glory of God:


  and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

- And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.




- And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof.
- And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth:
   and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs.

the twelfth, an amethyst. the eleventh, a jacinth; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the ninth, a topaz; the eighth, beryl; the seventh, chrysolite; the sixth, sardius; The fifth, sardonyx; the fourth, an emerald; the third, a chalcedony; the second, sapphire; The first foundation was jasper;



And the twelve gates were twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.

- <sup>22</sup> And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.
