The timeframe of the
THIRD millennial day
– Abraham to Solomon –
fits in verses 1-6 of the
“book of the generation of
Jesus Christ.”

This is the RISE of Israel.

Matthew 1:1-6

- 1 The book of the generation of Jesus Christ,
the son of David, the son of Abraham.
- 2 **Abraham** begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob;
and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren;
- 3 And Judas begat Phares and Zara of Thamar;
and Phares begat Esrom; and Esrom begat Aram;
- 4 And Aram begat Aminadab; and Aminadab begat
Naasson; and Naasson begat Salmon;
- 5 And Salmon begat Booz of Rachab; and Booz begat
Obed of Ruth; and Obed begat Jesse;
- 6 And Jesse begat David the king;
and David the king begat **Solomon** of her *that had
been the wife* of Urias;

Verses 7-16 correspond to the FOURTH DAY: Rehoboam to Christ

Matthew 1:7-16

- 7 And Solomon begat **Roboam**; and Roboam begat Abia; and Abia begat Asa;
- 8 And Asa begat Josaphat; and Josaphat begat Joram; and Joram begat Ozias;
- 9 And Ozias begat Joatham; and Joatham begat Achaz; and Achaz begat Ezekias;
- 10 And Ezekias begat Manasses; and Manasses begat Amon; and Amon begat Josias;
- 11 And Josias begat Jechonias and his brethren, about the time they were carried away to Babylon:

- 12 And after they were brought to Babylon, Jechonias begat Salathiel; and Salathiel begat Zorobabel;
- 13 And Zorobabel begat Abiud; and Abiud begat Eliakim; and Eliakim begat Azor;
- 14 And Azor begat Sadoc; and Sadoc begat Achim; and Achim begat Eliud;
- 15 And Eliud begat Eleazar; and Eleazar begat Matthan; and Matthan begat Jacob;
- 16 And Jacob begat Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom was born **Jesus, who is called Christ.**

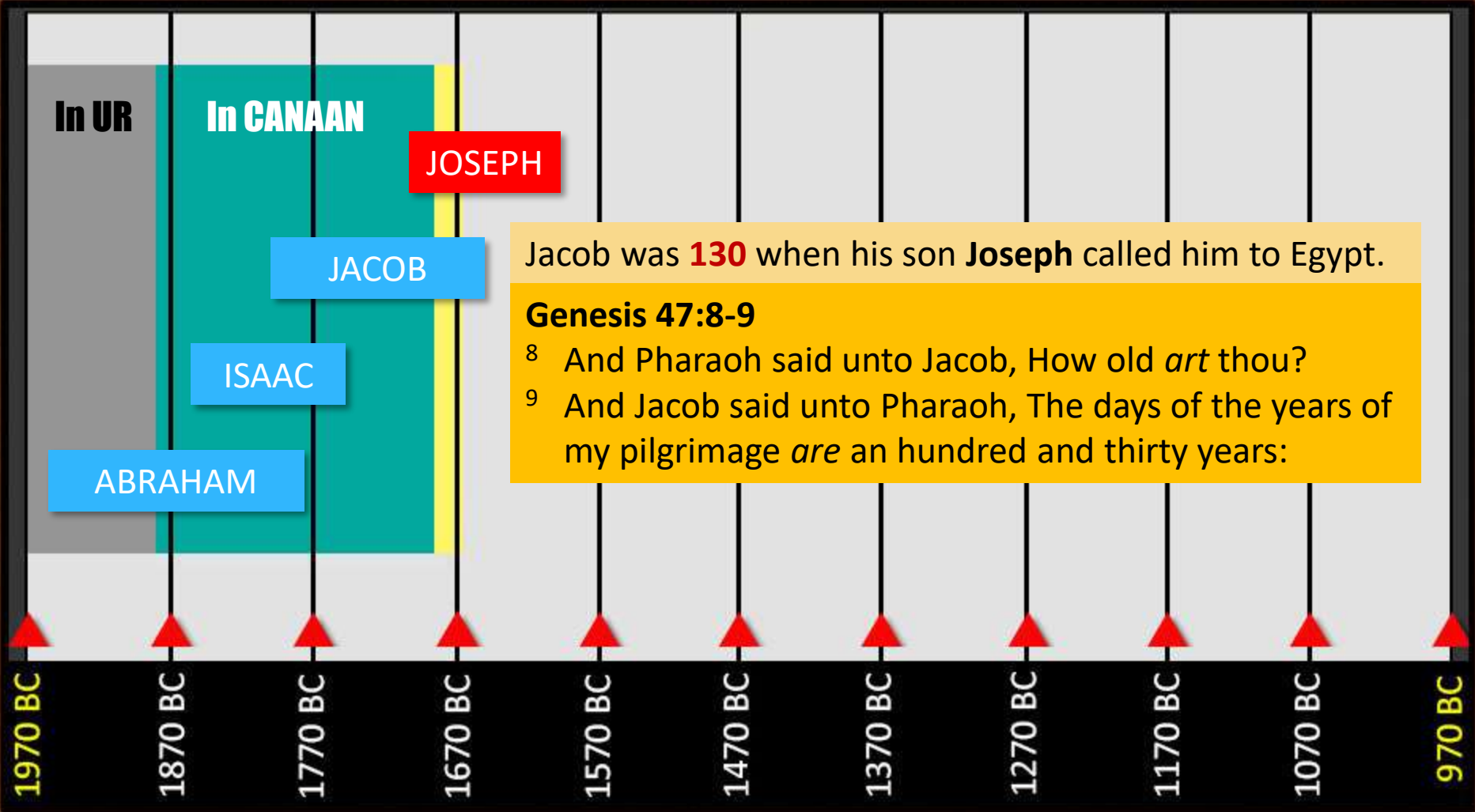

Jacob was 130 when Joseph called him to Egypt.

25 + 60 + 130 = 215 years from the call of Abraham to the day Joseph called his brethren into Egypt.

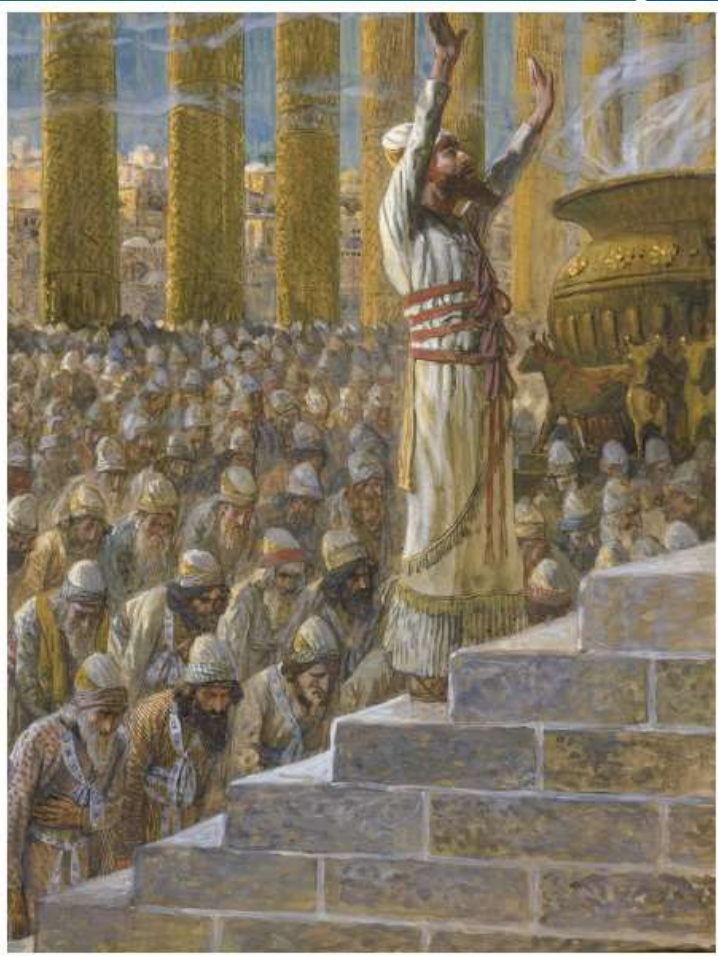


The high point in the RISE of Israel was the dedication of the House of God built by Solomon.



2 Chronicles 7:1-3

- ¹ Now when Solomon had made an end of praying, the fire came down from heaven, and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the glory of the LORD filled the house.
- ² And the priests could not enter into the house of the LORD, because the glory of the LORD had filled the LORD'S house.
- ³ And when all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the LORD upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and worshipped, and praised the LORD, *saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever.*



But it was the sins of this same man that led to the nation's decline.
